Activities included in PLAC II WP

.....Compatibility of national legislation with EU Acquis

- Drafting of the Acquis-compliant laws including support in regulatory impact assessment in general
- Drafting of TOC
- Drafting of by-laws
- Drafting other operational tools
- Improving action plans
- support to elaborate and/or fine-tune negotiating positions
- Preparing for practical aspects in implementation (competences and allocation of responsibilities, hierarchical aspects, reporting and data exchange...)







Activities included in PLAC II WP (cont)

If based on NPAA as national strategic document

.....Enhancing capacities of national structures

- capacity building activities and transfer of know-how
 - Workshops, Seminars, Retreats, On-the-job training
- $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ to enhance staff competences for actual operation
- $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ to learn from experience of MSs
- $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ to raise awareness of importance of actual implementation of necessary reforms







PLAC II implementation

Who carries it out and how:

- TA Team and selected NKEs Junior/Senior
 - 3290 WDs in total:
 - 1140 WDs for KEs
 - 2150 WDs for NKEs
 - 1106 NKE WDs planned for the 1st Y of implementation
- Draft ToRs are prepared by target beneficiaries
- Calls for application published on 3 web-sites
- Transparent procedure for selection of experts
- Proposals approved by DEU







PLAC II implementation NKEs can deliver their best

If target beneficiaries are aware of:

- Clear view on what needs to be done by NKE
 - drafting ToRs by TB is contributing to it
- Realistic planning in terms of timing of STE missions
- Preparations for missions of experts
 - Available internal resources of TB to work with the experts
 - Available work place for NKE at TB place
 - Available legal and other relevant documents translated to English
 - Available outputs from other projects to continue and avoid repetition or overlapping....
